Financial Information

PAY ID is our new method for one off donations, enabling you to send quick payments in real time.

Setup PayID:

1. Log on to your banking app and select 'Profile', then 'Manage PayID'. 2. Choose which type of PayID you'd like to register, then follow the prompts. 3. Choose an account to link to your PayID. 4. Confirm the name others will see.

Make donations using PayID:

1. Open your banking app and select 'Pay someone'. 2. Select PayID option, then Type: ABN, then Enter: 99 814 352 286. 3. Enter the amount. 4. Enter the description such as "Donation" or "Restoration" etc. and complete the payment.

The Sunday loose plate collection – One collection at the Offertory into which all contributions can be placed.

We understand that many people are facing financial hardship so please put your family needs ahead of church needs. Thank you for your support of our parish and religious community.

Sets of Envelopes for the New Financial Year 2023/2024 are now available.

If you are making contributions through the envelope system, your new set can be collected from the Monastery after making arrangements with Denise or Gail during office hours on 6234 4866. For record keeping purposes we will allocate the envelope number that you are currently using for this financial year. This will enable us to issue receipts at the end of each financial year to those people who have provided us with their name and address. We have several anonymous contributors who ideally need a number so that we can accurately declare the number of people contributing to our parish finances. **If you have started internet banking, you can continue to do so using your current envelope number as we will withdraw that set from general circulation. This enables you to use the envelopes if you choose to do so in the future.**

NOVEMBER MASSES: November is the month when the whole Church prays for all our departed brothers and sisters. Those who wish to have specific people remembered during this time may write clearly the names of their deceased on the envelopes provided, and enclose a small donation and place in the box provided. Each day one of the Parish Masses will be celebrated for the people whose names appear on the November Deceased List - **8.00am Monday to Saturday and 11.00am Sunday.**

Important Sunday Parking Notice (Does not apply to Saturday Vigil Mass)

St Joseph's has been issued with parking permits which cover the four spaces outside the church in Macquarie St. (but not the two spaces outside the Astor Grill) and eight spaces in Harrington St. from the corner down to the Monastery driveway. Parishioners who use these spaces for masses on Sunday need to collect permits and display the appropriate one on your dashboard. **The permits cover you from 7am till 4pm on Sunday, but only for the designated 12 spaces.** New Parking Permits from 20 December 2022 to 19 December 2023 are Available for Collection.
