Please do not leave handbags, parcels on the seats where you cannot see them because they may be stolen. During communion you need to carry these items with you. When placing donations in collection boxes make sure the notes and coins are pushed right in.

To protect everyone from the spread of **CORONA VIRUS** the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) has issued the following guidelines taking advice from by the appropriate Health Authorities.

- 1. Holy water is to be removed from the holy water fonts.**
- 2. During the Eucharist there is to be no shared drinking from the chalice.**
- 3. Everyone is requested to receive communion on the hand. The option of receiving communion on the tongue has the greater risk of spreading the CORONA VIRUS for the communion minister and recipients because of the possibility of saliva exchange.**
- 4. At the sign of peace please acknowledge each other but without giving a hand shake (eg nod or bow).**
- 5. Eucharistic ministers are to sanitize their hands before and after communion.**
- 6. People who are unwell should not feel obliged to attend mass.**

These guidelines will be kept in place until the **CORONA VIRUS Crisis ends** or we are otherwise advised by the ACBC (Full text of ACBC recommendations on the notice board)
